### **General Comments** - to be followed up at next meeting

- Booster and catch up sessions back to back can be too intense and tiring
- Students should be able to opt in to available intervention classes
- School trips and visits are really appreciated
- Students are looking forward to returning to Rewards Assemblies
- Uniform could be gender neutral - blazers and ties for girls
- Introduce some 'Culture Days'

### **Restaurant**

- Queue is much better but there is still room for improvement
- More variety and more food and drinks would be appreciated
- Thumb Scanning machine needs cleaning regularly
- 'Grab and Go' items should be well packaged
- Prices for some items e.g. water can be too expensive



### **Toilets**

- Toilets need to be more available, and more regularly cleaned with locks on doors
- Paper towels, soap and sanitary bins must be available at all times

- More activities, especially for girls, required to help reduce noise levels and improve quality of lunchtime
- Somewhere to sit down inside as it is very cold outside
- During KS4 lunchtime, KS3 PE lessons have taken place on the playground - less space for KS4 to play football

- More students would like to have access to the table tennis courts
