Dear Parents and Carers

Good attendance and punctuality are essential in allowing students to reach their full potential at Winchmore School, in fact research shows that there is a direct link between good attendance and punctuality and student academic progress and achievement.

We are therefore writing to you to inform you of our new late procedure for Years 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 students which will come into effect on Monday 31October 2022 following the half term break.

Lesson 1 starts at 8:30am, students need to be in the school playground by 8:20am to enable them to get into the school building and to class on time. Please note that students should enter school through the Highfield Road or Firs Lane entrance, these gates shut at 8:30am. If students arrive after 8.30am they must enter the school via the Laburnum Grove entrance.

Students can start the day with a **free bagel breakfast** between 7:45am - 8:20am in the school's restaurant. In addition to the free breakfast students are able to purchase a cooked breakfast and other light refreshments at this time. This is an excellent opportunity for students to prepare themselves for the school day.

Students who are late to school on more than one occasion will be required to attend the Lunchtime Late Workshop. Students who do not attend this will be required to stay in school until 4:00pm on Friday (texts will be sent to inform parents of this on the Friday morning. Please make sure the school has your current mobile number).
