- The online appointment system opens at 6.00pm on Thursday 4th May 2023 and will close at 4.00pm on Wednesday 10th May 2023.
- Appointments are on a 'first come first served basis'. Please select one appointment time for each teacher and if you need to make a change to your appointment time after 4pm on Wednesday 10th May please contact the school office.
- Please note that the meeting will last 5 minutes from its scheduled start time. This is to ensure that staff can meet as many parents/carers as possible during the evening. I would like to make you aware that there is no way to extend this as the timings are built into the video conferencing system.
- If you wish to speak further to a specific subject teacher about your child's progress, please contact the member of staff separately outside of the parents/carers' evening.
