UCAS Applications

Students applying to university have been advised to use their Unifrog account to support them with their research and decision making and to register with the Universities and Colleges Admissions Service (UCAS), to start completing their online application. When doing so students must use the 'buzzword' Winchmore 2024 to link their application to the school.

All students should write a draft personal statement ready for the beginning of term in September. We will continue to advise and support those not applying to university with their apprenticeship, job or alternative college applications throughout the next academic year. We do advise every student to make a UCAS application, as every year we have those who change their mind about not applying.

Enrolment For Next Academic Year

Next week all students who have successfully passed their courses will be notified of their automatic enrolment into Year 13. All students studying our one year pathway programme will have been interviewed by Mr Jama to discuss their progression and any support we can offer them. Meetings will also be held with any students who may need to select an alternative pathway due to their exam results and you will be contacted separately regarding this.

As Year 12 progress into Year 13, Ms Bevan, The Head of Sixth Form, will now be taking responsibility for the year group. Please address any emails or telephone calls to Ms Bevan regarding your child moving forward.
