

'WINCHMORE'S WORD OF THE WEEK' CHALLENGE - week beginning 6th Nov:

Word of the Week: Kerfuffle

Word Class	Noun
Meaning	A commotion or fuss, especially one caused by conflicting views.
Examples	 The unexpected arrival of a circus in our small town caused quite a kerfuffle among the residents. The kerfuffle between the neighbours started when one of them mistakenly took the other's newspaper. A minor kerfuffle ensued when the two friends couldn't decide on the movie they wanted to watch, causing a delay in their movie night plans.
Challenge	How many different words can you make with the letters in 'kerfuffle'? K - E - R - F - U - F - F - L - E E.g. fuel, refuel

What's the challenge? You must use the 'word of the week' in the correct context (where possible) in any of your subjects. If you are able to use it in the correct context (not just going up to your teacher and saying it – has to be relevant to what you are doing), you will get I 'word of the week' achievement point.

Why are we doing this? To widen our vocabulary, oracy and understanding alongside encouraging a love for literacy across the school (in all subject areas).

Remember: that the student with the most 'word of the week' achievement points in the year group at the end of the half term will receive a voucher!


