The afternoon Final was hosted by TikTok star Magician Ben Hanlin and entertainment was also provided by one of the semi Finalists from Britain's Got Talent.

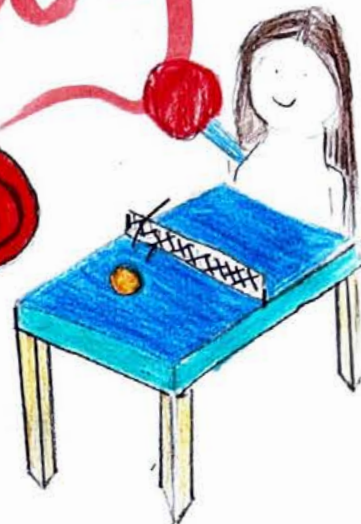
Mrs Winter had an article published in the Final programme highlighting Winchmore School's journey with the NCC over the last eleven years.

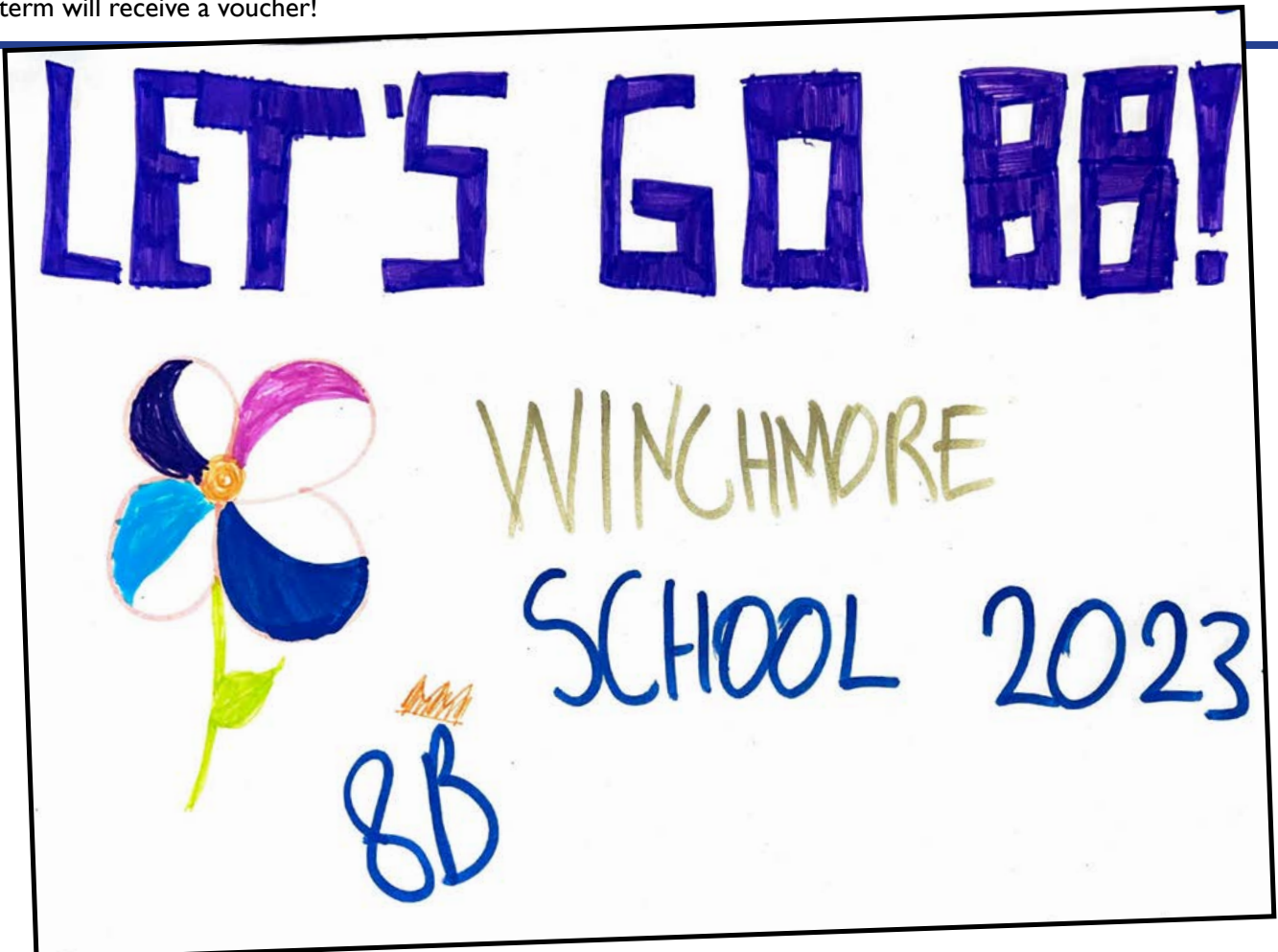
Word of the Week: **Elated**

What's the challenge? You must use the 'word of the week' in the correct context (where possible) in any of your subjects. If you are able to use it in the correct context (not just going up to your teacher and saying it – has to be relevant to what you are doing), you will get 1 'word of the week' achievement point.
