

How to access Science Student Interface




- **3** Scan the QR Code below.
 - Open your phone camera and point towards the QR Code, it should automatically pop op the ink or counce student interface.



 Once Science student interface opens, please make a bookmark or save it under favourites on your web browser.



5. Sign in – Click the sign in text on the student interface and Log in using your 'Winchmore school' email id and password. (if you are already signed in with your personal email id then please remember to sign out / Log out and sign in using your winchmore school email id)



6. Once you are signed in using school email id and password just retype the Student interface web address or refresh if webpage is already open and you will be able to access all the resources without any issue:

On Thursday a number of our Dance and Drama students had the opportunity to hear from our guest speaker Piers Shepperd from Wonder Works.

Over the last 25 years Piers' career has spanned design, production management, lighting, automation and development of cutting edge manufacturing processes involving clients from Her Majesty the Queen to Queen the rock band.

Initially he picked up skills in lighting and fabrication with industry leaders including: Vari-Lite, Theatre Projects and Brilliant Stages. In the late 1990's he moved into technical design and worked to deliver critically acclaimed projects such as: We Will Rock You, U2 Popmart Tour, and Rolling Stones Licks World Tour.

As Technical Director for London 2012 Ceremonies, Piers oversaw the delivery of four unique and spectacular Ceremonies that wowed the world.

Piers is currently working on the Ed Sheeran tour as well as ABBA Voyage amongst a host of other projects.



Trip to Kenya

Our students are travelling to Kenya in 2024 with Camps International on an exciting four week expedition in the summer. This is an opportunity for both Staff and Students.
