Art trip-St. Paul's Primary School

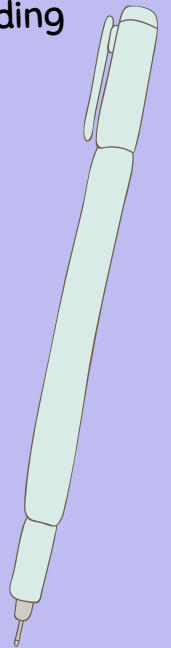
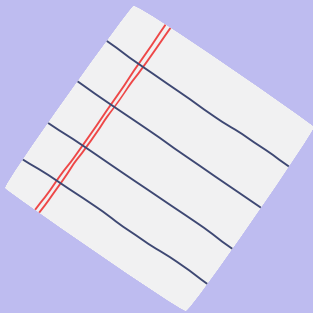

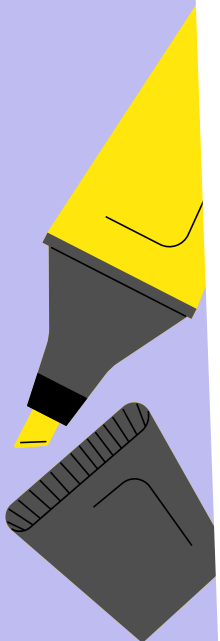


Tips for language revision

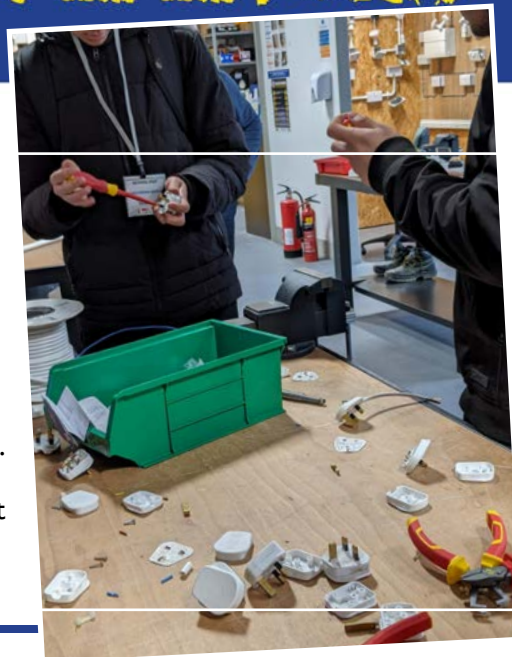


Visit to Enfield College
