Prospective Year 7 Parents' and Carers' Open Evening Wednesday 25 September 2024

In order to allow staff to prepare for our prospective Year 7 Parents' and Carers' Evening, school will finish early on Wednesday, 25 September, at 1.20pm. The school restaurant will only be open at break time to all students on this day. Students who receive a free school meal will be able to collect a packed lunch at that time.

All after-school activities, including homework clubs, will not take place on this day. However, your child will be able to remain in school in a supervised study room, until the end of the normal school day at 3.00pm. If you wish your child to use the supervised study room please contact the school office in advance, in order for us to know how many students to expect.

In addition, it will be necessary for the school to have a late start on Thursday, 26 September, to allow for clearing up after our Open Evening. Pupils should be in school by 9.20am for the beginning of lesson 2 which starts promptly at 9.30am.

If you are planning to attend our Open Evening, please be aware that we are operating an online booking system which includes 4 half hour sessions from 6.00pm to 8.00pm as shown below:

Session 1	6.00pm – 6.30pm
Session 2	6.30pm – 7.00pm
Session 3	7.00pm – 7.30pm
Session 4	7.30pm – 8.00pm

Each session will start with a presentation by Mr Owen, the Headteacher, followed by a tour of the school.


