Arrangements for the Start of the New Year 2025/2026

I am writing to inform you about the arrangements for the beginning of the new academic year.

Monday 1 September	School is open to Year 13 only 11.15am-12.15pm - Year 13 Welcome (Assembly + tutor time)
Tuesday 2 September	School is open to Year 12 only 11.15am-13.15pm - Year 13 Welcome (Assembly + tutor time)
Wednesday 3 September	School is open to Year 7 only School day starts promptly at 8.30am. We recommend that students arrive at school at 8.25am via Laburnum Grove on this day only. School will finish at 2.00pm on this day only. <i>Students will be dismissed via the Firs Lane and Highfield Road gates. If you are picking up your child, please make sure they know which gate you'll be at to collect them from.</i>
Thursday 4 September	Year 7 - Normal school day - 8.30am-3.00pm <i>Students must enter via Firs Lane or Highfield Road gate.</i> Years 8-11 in school for Tutor Time and Welcome Assembly <i>Students to enter and leave school via Laburnum Grove on this day only. Students to wear full school uniform and go straight to their tutor room.</i> Year 8 - 8.30am - 9.30am Year 9 - 9.30am - 10.30am Year 10 - 11.15am - 12.15pm Year 11 - 12.15pm - 1.15pm
Friday 5 September	Normal School Day - 8.30am-3.00pm for all Years Year 12 - start period 3 (11.15am)


In the interest of everyone's health and safety please do not drop your child off in Laburnum Grove.
