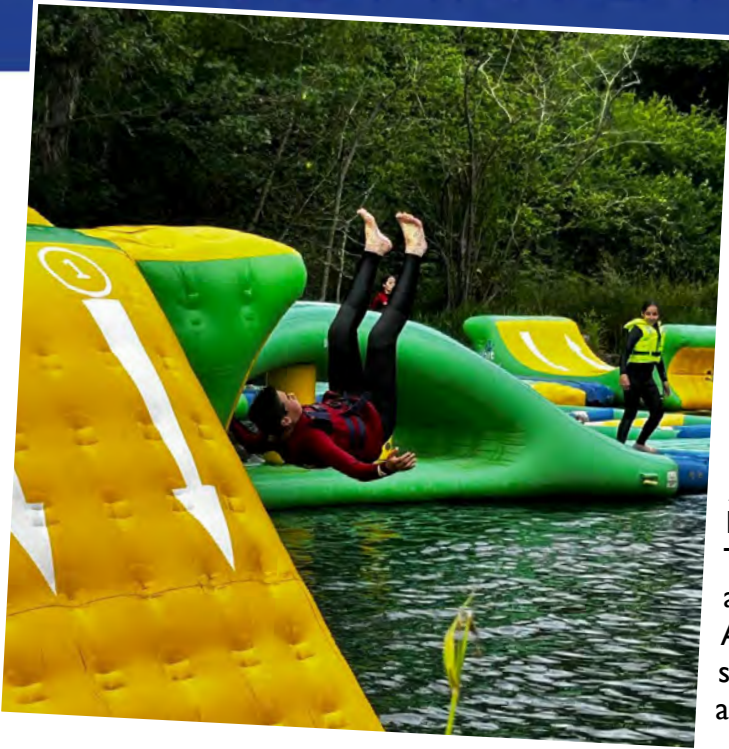

Enfield Council Parent Travel Survey 2025



Through the Journeys and Places programme, Enfield Council supports schools to encourage walking, wheeling and cycling amongst students, parents and staff. We work closely with schools across the borough to become Travel for Life accredited. Travel for Life is a Transport for London initiative that recognises the work of schools to encourage sustainable travel to school.

We are inviting parents of students in Enfield and staff at Enfield schools to take part in the Parent and Staff Travel Survey. The data we collect helps us to understand how people are travelling to schools in Enfield and what the barriers to sustainable travel might be.
