Our KS4 curriculum caters for students of all abilities, from the most academic (EBACC Pathway, following the 'EBACC' principles) to the more flexible Open Pathway. Students following the Core Pathway have the additional support of booster lessons in the Core subjects, which enables them to continue their studies at Level 3 (Key Stage 5). We are proud to offer a wide range of Options choices, as listed above. In addition, in Year 10 we enter a large number of students each year for Community Language GCSEs (e.g. in Russian, Greek, Arabic, Turkish etc) and an increasing number take Level 2 Further Maths GCSE.
